Product Description:

Flu✓Check contains personal protection equipment to help guard against the spread of the influenza virus within your work and school environment. Flu✓Check provides you with thermometer strips to detect fever, a protective mask, an EPA registered broad spectrum disinfectant* to disinfect contact surfaces within your immediate work area, antimicrobial hand wipes to clean your hands to help reduce the chance of contaminating others by hand contact, and a re-sealable bag to safely dispose of all items.

WHO should use the Flu✓Check Kit?

Any individual within your organization or facility that appears to have flu-like symptoms such as chills, sneezing, coughing, nasal congestion and body aches.

WHAT is the purpose of the Flu✓Check Kit?

To quickly attempt to reduce the further spread of the influenza virus to others from the infected person. The Flu✓Check kit contains the basic personal protection equipment that helps guard against transmission to others.

WHEN do I use a Flu✓Check Kit?

Immediately at the first signs of flu-like symptoms, especially fever, chills, sneezing, coughing, lethargy. Use the Flu✓Check Kit as directed. Consult a physician immediately when fever is present.

WHERE is the best use for the Flu✓Check Kit?

- **In the Office:** in every employee desk drawer as a standard office tool.
- **In the Schools:** a perfect protection kit for the school nurse to screen the student and disinfect potentially contaminated surfaces.
- **In Healthcare:** Mobile units, Emergency care, high-risk departments, staff members.
- **Public Health:** Villages, townships, cities, counties, government agencies, police and fire departments.
- **Public Facilities:** Food processing plants, correctional facilities, manufacturing plants.
- **Nursing Homes:** the elderly are more susceptible to flu and cold viruses and need immediate protection.
- **Military:** large number of personnel could be contaminated if policies are not implemented to help reduce the spread of influenza immediately.
- **Call Centers:** Telemarketing and computer labs where many different employees share common equipment and common use areas.



WHY should I use Flu✓Check Kit in our facility?

- To help reduce the spread of influenza to co-workers/employees, students, patients or staff.
- To help avoid higher than average absenteeism.

HOW can I tell if symptoms are caused by the flu?

Initial symptoms may be the same as the common cold until a diagnosis of influenza is determined by a physician. It is during this time that the flu is likely to be most contagious – emphasizing the importance of using the personal protection equipment in Flu✓Check. It is best to assume that symptoms are caused by influenza until proven otherwise.

Facts you should know

- It's estimated that more than 100 million sick days per year are recorded due to flu and cold viruses. This equates to over \$40 billion in wages, not to mention loss of productivity.
- Each year over 200 million school days are missed due to colds and the flu.
- One cough or sneeze can release more than 100,000 infectious particles in the air.
- Flu and cold viruses can live on counters, desks, computer keyboards, phones, doorknobs for up to 24 hours.
- Proper hand hygiene with antimicrobial wipes is helpful in reducing the contamination of others in the work place and school environment.
- The CDC reports that in the United States, Influenza A viruses accounted for 71% of the specimens testing positive for flu by public health laboratories.

The disinfectant wipe in Flu✓Check has an EPA label claim for Influenza A.

Using Flu✓Check is simple, quick and effective (specific directions are on every kit)

- Open re-sealable, clear bag and remove disposable temperature strips (extra temp strips included).
- Apply temperature strips as directed. Temp strips will indicate if fever is present.
- If a fever is present, use mask immediately to cover nose and mouth.
- Use EPA registered disinfectant wipe to clean your immediate work area including phone, computer, desk, keyboards, headset, tools, equipment or any item you have touched that day.
- Have tissues available for nose and to cover mouth when coughing.
- Wipe hands thoroughly with antimicrobial hand wipe (extra wipes included).
- Discard all used wipes, tissues, masks and temp strips in re-sealable bag for proper disposal.
